A Lithuanian man was charged €600 for the salmon he caught in the Slaney by Judge Gerard Haughton when he pleaded guilty to charges brought by the **Inland Fisheries Ireland**.

Pranas Virvicius of 45 Ferns Bridge, Monasterevin, Co. Kildare, also lost his fishing tackle, which was declared forfeit by the judge.

IFI inspector Myles Roban told the District Court how he was on duty on May 25, 2014, in the Tombrack area when he came across Virvicius and the salmon, which was in a black bin bag.
